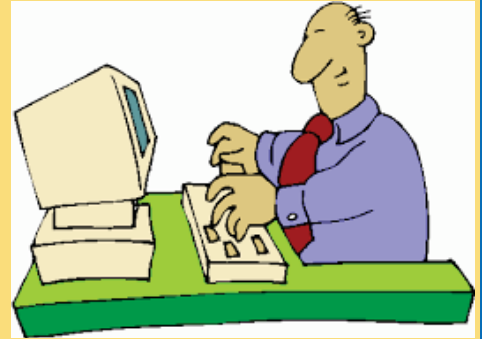

The Massachusetts “Money Management Program” is a free service which promotes independent living by assisting income eligible seniors, aged sixty & older, who may be at risk of losing their independence due to their failure to pay rent, utility or other basic bills on time. Volunteers trained & certified, meet with consumers in their homes to help them balance their checkbooks, pay bills, and manage their money wisely. Volunteers also help to educate the consumer as to how they can avoid becoming a victim of fraud, scams, or financial exploitation. Commitment of 2-4 hours a month is required. Volunteers will meet at 7:30 am in Chatham, carpool to Stage harbor, and depart for Monomoy at 8:30 am. 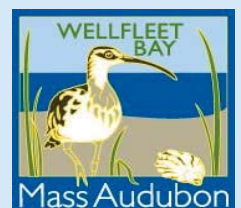


## Wellfleet's Annual Coastsweep Event
