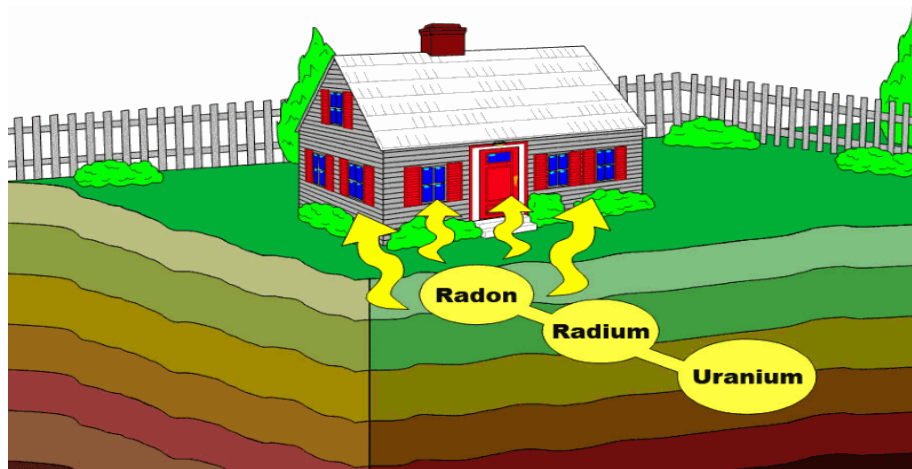
Consumer Assistance Council

The partnership between RSVP of Cape Cod and the Islands and the Consumer Assistance Council (CAC), Inc. dates back to 2000. The CAC, which has been located in Hyannis for over twenty years, is one of only 18 local consumer groups operating throughout Massachusetts and is staffed mainly by a team of volunteers. CAC is the only consumer group serving the Cape and Islands.

Currently, CAC functions under the sponsorship, funding and guidance of the Attorney General of Massachusetts (AGO) and is led by Executive Director, Marie C. Clougher. The primary objective of the CAC is to help assure relations between sellers of goods and services, and consumers are conducted in a fair and equitable manner. To achieve this objective, they conduct programs to educate consumers on their rights under the Consumer Protection Act, Massachusetts General Laws and related rules and regulations.
